Common Budgie health issues

Prevention is the best advice that can be given!

Issue	Symptom		Treatment
Air Sack Mite	Asthma type wheeze		Moxidectin
Canker	Lethargic, won't eat, sitting in corner, stretching neck upwards, possible cheesy deposits in throat		Turobosole
Coccidiosis	Dark green/Red sticky droppings due to internal bleeding, spreads rapidly throughout entire flight		See Avian vet for diagnosis Toltravet Sulfa 3
Enteritis	Green diarrhoea, stained green vent, usually from dirty flights		Sulfa 3
French Molt	Chick lose feathers in the nest or shortly after, Immune system Virus		Clean bird room and breeding boxes, sterilize with F10 and replace sawdust regularly.
Megabacteria	Birds lethargic, fluffed up, diagnosed by vet	No real treatment, prevent with citric acid or Apple cider vinegar in water, or feed citrus fruit	
Red mite and bird lice	Small mites living on birds or in bird housing	Moxidectin or spry with an avian insecticide such as Vetafarm Liquidator	
Scaly face	Fungus growth on beak, around eyes, legs and vent	Moxidectin or brush on scaly face medication	
Psittacosis	Eye discharge or swelling, laboured breathing, diarrhoea, poor appetite, leathergy	See Avian vet for diagnosis Doxycline -	
Worms	Going light, loss of condition, perhaps diarrhoea		xidectin or similar worm atment

Issue	Medication	Treatment
Airsack mite Redmite / Bird Lice Scaley face Worms	Moxidectin	Preventative dose as per instructions
Redmite & bird lice	As above and/or Avian Liquidator	Spray birds and housing as per instructions
Coccidiosis Enteritis	Toltravet Sulfa 3	Preventative dose as per instructions
Canker	Turbosol	Preventative dose as per instructions
Megabacteria	Citric acid/ Citrus fruit Apple cider vinegar	Citric acid, 1gm to 1 liter of water ACV - 2 ml to 1 liter of water
