
**FEBRUARY TRAINING PRESENTATION – DARK EYED CLEAR & RECESSIVE PIEDS –

## ADULT BIRD CHAMPIONSHIP & TEAM SELECTION – Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> February:

This will be the first club show for the year, and is being held on at the club rooms 1<sup>st</sup> Eaglemont Scout Hall, Irvine Road, East Ivanhoe.

Setup will be from 9am with the judging commencing at 10am.


### Help comes in all forms:

**NOTE: This is a night show!!**


The ANNUAL INTERCLUB COMPETITION BETWEEN United – Eastern & Dandenong is on again.

A BCV certificate will be awarded and points allocated as per the BCV rules.




