Please ensure that all cages have a sticker on the back with your ring code and ring number recorded.

We hope to see all members there to help out on the day, even if they don't have birds to bench. The club requires a strong team of birds in all varieties to represent our club at the Shield the following weekend, to win.

This is also a great opportunity for beginners to learn how to steward.

At the selection we will select 3 birds to represent the club.

In addition, <u>beginner & intermediate</u> birds can be entered on a separate sheet supplied, (no limit with numbers entered). These birds will compete against the top 3 from all clubs in each class at the shield.

We can only look forward now to our domestic show season and our State Championship Shows which are commencing in the coming weeks. The BCV Council urges everyone to participate in these shows and have developed a COVID Safety Policy which should be implemented by all clubs not only for your members safety but those of the exhibitors and attending Judges as well as any members of the general public attending.

To help us understand who is breeding what varieties we ask that you fill in the attached form and return.


This will help us with our forward planning and assist encouragement of breeding the varieties that we are short off.
