Agony Aunt's Column

Question: I have a hen (a good one as usual), who probably only lays every third egg in the nest box. Any ideas how to get her to lay in the nest box, and not on the perch. Furthermore, she lays pointy eggs with a little nib at the end, and so far, have been infertile.

Answer: These issues can occur thankfully only with a small number of birds. With the eggs being pointy with a nib on the

end, I suggest you at least place soft nesting material under perch and maybe try a different nesting material in nest box. Eggs laid from the perch can be retrieved if not broken and put under hen in nest box. Sometimes a cock bird can be too vigorous and not allow the hen to go to nest box to lay. If so you may need to change cock bird. Hope these suggestions may be of assistance with your problem in future.

United's Budgie Sale and Auction

Steve Bradley, our Vice President, has recommended club's bird sales this time using 32auctions.

The following rules apply:

- Birds must be of good show quality and in a healthy condition;
- Equal numbers of hens and cock birds; AND Ages of birds are the same as for auctions.

(Remember that the birds you submit not only reflect on you BUT on the club as a whole.)

There is a link to 32auctions on the club website as well as the Facebook page. Or <u>click here</u> to go to currently running online auction.

If you have birds available for the auction, please message or call Steve to discuss on 0417 300 667 or email him on <u>steve.bradley29@hotmail.com</u>.

Following that, Steve will require:

- a filled-in pro forma entry sheet (the entry sheet can be downloaded from United's website in the forms section);
- photos of your birds;
- In the appropriate section on the entry sheet, please set your starting price. This acts like a reserve (please be realistic). However, Steve reserves the right to question the reserve; AND
- detailed comments about the birds in the comments area which include bloodlines and positive points about the birds

Once the photos have been added to the Facebook page promoting the forthcoming auction, you can forward Steve a 10 to 15 second video of each bird detailing all the bird (head to tail). Alternatively, you can add the video in the comments area of each photo.

(Remember it is also a club fundraiser and 10% of all sales goes towards the club.)

This process is more time consuming for Steve than the online FB sales, so please be realistic of the birds you submit.

"If you would not buy it at an auction, then nobody else will either".

Thanks to everyone who supported our first auction last night. The next one will commence next Friday, 6th August.

Again, we look forward to hearing from you and appreciate you supporting your club. ③
